During her time with Penn Medicine, she supported over 700 patients with advocacy and navigation of resources so they could stay in the community healthily. Since December 2021 Lisa has been a Training Specialist with the Drexel University Center for Non-Violence and Social Justice Healing Centered Learning Academy. In this role, Lisa has co-facilitated the Experiential Learning Program (ELP). This program prepares and develops field placements for the Community Health Worker/ Certified Peer Specialist interns to work with local industry partners in supporting people who are living with substance use disorder and behavioral health needs. Lisa is an advisory board member of the American Board of Family Medicine, Center for Professionalism and Value. She is also an ECHO Hub Member for the PA AHEC CHW Training Program.
